

**INTERNATIONAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**  
**UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS**

International students seeking admission to the Madonna University on the I-20 status must submit the following documentation before applications can be processed:

1. \_\_\_\_\_ Completed application form
2. \_\_\_\_\_ Official school records including subject studied, grades and degrees earned, and graduation date.
3. \_\_\_\_\_ Official test results indicating English proficiency.
  - TOEFL score of at least 523 (Paper Based), 70 (Internet Based); MELAB score of 76, or IELTS score of 6.
  - This requirement is waived for applicants with one of the following qualifications:
    - ✓ Applicants who are citizens of countries where English is the native language, including Great Britain, Ireland, Canada, Australia, or New Zealand; or
    - ✓ Applicants who achieve a score of 21 on the ACT English sub score or a score of 500 on the SAT reading score; or
    - ✓ Applicants who matriculate from the British high school system, and who have completed at least three Advanced Level examinations; or
    - ✓ Applicants who come directly from high school with the completion of the International Baccalaureate diploma (IB) with a minimum of 3 higher level subjects; or
    - ✓ Applicants who have 24 transferrable college credits from regionally accredited universities and colleges in the US or who have graduated from an American university.
  - Applicants who do not meet this requirement will be required to take an English placement test administered by Madonna University. Based on the test result, students may be considered for conditional admission and be required to take English language classes.
4. \_\_\_\_\_ International Student Financial Support Form along with financial statements from a bank, government agency, or other financial institution issued within the most recent six months.
5. \_\_\_\_\_ Copy of passport identification page.

**Application Deadlines for International Students:**

Fall Semester: April 1 for overseas applicants, May 1 for applicants transferring in the US.

Winter Semester: October 1 for overseas applicants, November 1 for applicants transferring in the US.

Spring/Summer Semester: February 1 for overseas applicants, March 1 for applicants transferring in the US.

**Please note:**

All international students are required to live on campus during the first year of the study. The Residence Hall information will be sent to the student after the student is admitted.

All international students at Madonna University are required to have medical insurance coverage in the United States. Students can either provide proof in English of catastrophic health insurance coverage in the United States or purchase a medical insurance plan through Madonna University.
