



Admission Requirements

Master of Arts in Teaching: Autism Spectrum Disorders

Applications are evaluated based on the following:

- Possession of a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution with an undergraduate grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. An average of less than 3.0 will be reviewed for conditional admission.
- Two letters of recommendation from current supervisor or professional persons.
- Valid Michigan teaching certificate, current or expired. An expired certificate must be renewed to be ASD endorsed.
- Prior or concurrent teaching experience.
- Admission interview with the Coordinator of the Autism Spectrum Disorders Program.

Students may transfer up to six semester hours of credit with departmental approval. Students may take up to six semester hours prior to admission.
