



Admission Requirements

Master of Arts in Pastoral Ministry

Applications are evaluated based on the following:

- Possession of a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution with an undergraduate grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Undergraduate courses in Old and New Testaments and an Introduction to Philosophy. Students lacking these prerequisites may test out or be required to take the appropriate courses prior to beginning the program.
- Two recommendations (University forms) from current employers or professionals who can speak **to applicant's aptitude for this program.**
- Submission of a statement of purpose with projected goals and objectives to be realized through the program.
- Admission interview with a member of the Religious Studies Department with personal background clearance related to any past criminal record.
