Applications are evaluated based on the following:

- Possession of a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution with an undergraduate grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. An average of less than 3.0 will be considered for conditional admission.
- Two letters of recommendation from current employer or professional associates familiar with the applicant's work or college performance.
- Interview with a School of Business faculty advisor. International students unable to visit the campus for an interview will submit an autobiographical essay focusing on the questions in the application packet.
- Full-time employment. International students unable to pursue full-time employment in the United States while completing a graduate degree may be admitted to the program if the student has prior substantive full-time work experience. The work experience record will be reviewed by the School of Business Admission Committee.
- Current résumé.
