



Certificate Eligibility

Post-MSN Certificate: Adult Primary Care Nurse Practitioner

Graduates of this certificate program are prepared to take the national certification examination as an Adult Nurse Practitioner offered by the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC) or the American Academy of Nurse Practitioners (AANP). This renders the graduate eligible for Nurse Practitioner specialty certification by the Michigan Board of Nursing.

The certificate provides 691 clock hours of supervised direct patient care. Currently-**certified NP's who are** expanding into this area of practice may request a waiver of selected courses and clinical experiences. This is individually determined upon admission by gap analysis.
