MISSION STATEMENT

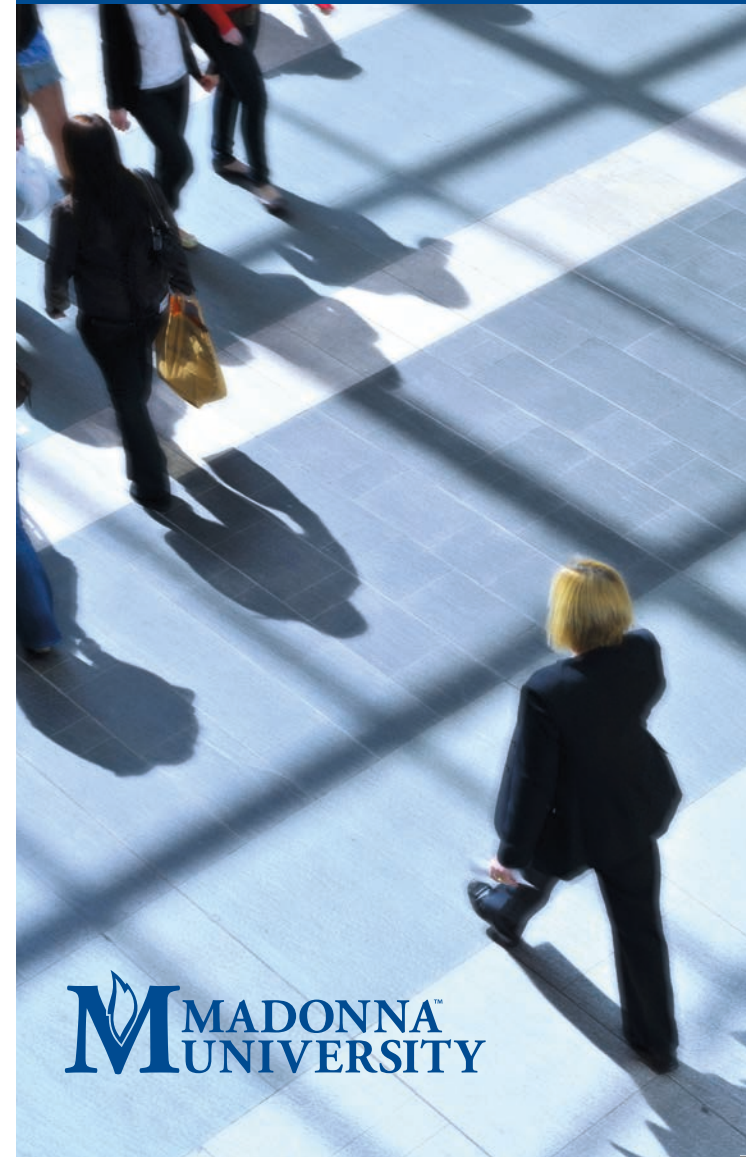
