Health Insurance

The cost of health care in the U.S. is high because none of the medical facilities available here are government owned. All International students at Madonna University are required to carry catastrophic health insurance that is valid in the United States.

If students would like to use a plan from their home country to meet the medical insurance coverage requirement, they need to send proof of coverage, in English, via fax to the University Student Accounts Office, 734-432-5344, and send an e-mail to sa@madonna.edu to confirm that the fax has been sent. Such proof and notice have to reach the Student Account Office no later than Friday of the first week of classes. Without such proof, students must purchase student insurance through Madonna University. Student accounts will be automatically charged the cost of the insurance if no proof of medical insurance is received by the Student Account Office by the deadline. After the deadline, no credit for health insurance will be processed.
