MBA - Master of Business Administration

The MBA program is a generalist program in business administration, which stresses the functional areas of business. It is meant for those students who desire a broad understanding of business and how it relates to the social, political, and economic forces confronting it.

MSBA - Leadership Studies

The Master of Science in Business Administration with a specialty in leadership studies offers a planned program of educational experiences for the graduate interested in advancing in a key leadership role in business or other complex organization. This program is also offered as a Cohort On-Line Program for individuals with significant computer literacy.

MSBA - Leadership Studies in Criminal Justice

The Master of Science in Business Administration with a specialty in criminal justice offers a planned program of educational experiences for the graduate interested in advancing in a key leadership role in criminal justice or other complex organization.

MSBA - Quality Operations Management

The Master of Science in Business Administration with a specialty in quality and operations management offers a planned program of educational experiences for the graduate student involved in either manufacturing or nonmanufacturing environments.

MSBA - International Business

The Master of Science in Business Administration with a specialty in international business offers a planned program of educational experiences for the graduate student involved in international business. Students in this program are experienced employees who have demonstrated their potential for future achievement in the international area.

MSBA - Medical and Dental Practice Administration

The Master of Science in Business Administration degree program in Medical and Dental Practice Administration

distinguishes itself as the only one of its kind in the United States to focus exclusively on private practice leadership.

Admission Requirements

Admission to the School of Business is determined on the basis of the following criteria:

1. Possession of a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution with an undergraduate grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. (An average of less than 3.0 will be reviewed for conditional admission.)
2. Two letters of recommendation from current employer or professional persons.
3. Submission of a statement of purpose for participating in the MBA Program. A resume demonstrating full-time employment or substantiated prior full-time work experience for the MSBA Program.
4. Admission interview with a member of the School of Business Admission Committee.

Transfer Students

Students may transfer up to 6 semester hours of credit, with departmental approval.

Tuition

The tuition rate for the 2000-2001 academic year is \$288.00 per semester hour.
