**The history major** at Madonna University is composed of 36 semester hours, which include courses that provide chronological depth and geographical breadth. In addition to the required core history courses, you will have the opportunity to select elective courses corresponding to your individual interests, including World Problems, the Vietnam War, the Civil Rights Movement, Michigan History, the American Civil War, Diplomatic History of U.S., and Race, Ethnicity and Class in American Life. Telecourses and other distance learning methods are readily available. A **minor in history** is also available.

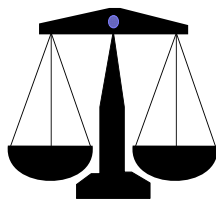
**Your history advisor** can help you combine your history studies with other professional majors and minors of your choice, including teacher education, business and pre-law studies. Foreign travel and language studies are highly encouraged, but not required. Our advising includes consideration of your after-graduation studies and employment.

### Teacher Education Certificate in History

The programs of the history department have been approved by the State of Michigan Department of Education. The history department works closely with the College of Education at Madonna University to prepare students seeking teaching certificates at the elementary, middle school, and secondary levels. ### Pre-Law

Madonna University is well prepared to guide your preparation for law school. If you indicate an interest in law school when you register, you will be assigned a pre-law advisor who will guide you throughout your studies. Law schools do not prescribe particular curricula for admission. Madonna approaches the



preparation for law on an individual basis, designing the program of each student to meet individual needs and goals. Pre-law students may major in fields of their choice, including English, history, political science, and legal assistant. Your pre-law advisor will assist you in selecting courses, considering law schools, preparing for the Law School Admissions Test, and applying to the law schools of your choice.
