“Art on the Side” Exhibition at Madonna University

Proceeds to help refurbish exhibit gallery

What: The “Art on the Side” exhibition opens Sunday, Oct. 3 with a reception and silent auction from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. at the Madonna University Gallery. The exhibit showcases the work of Madonna faculty, staff, and students who create art outside of their daytime profession. Funds raised from the sale of the artwork, donated by the artists, will be used to improve the Gallery.

The exhibit features oil paintings, watercolor illustrations, black and white photography, and etchings, as well as prints and drawings by well known metro-Detroit artist and Madonna Art Department Chairman Douglas Semivan.

Many of the exhibitions in Madonna’s Gallery have featured the work of artists from the Metro Detroit area, the U.S. and abroad. With constant use over the years, the display cases now are showing some disrepair. Most notably, the walls are peeling and need to be replaced. Gallery lighting also requires some enhancement. Proceeds from the “Art on the Side” silent auction will help make these improvements, so the Gallery continues to be a sanctuary for the arts.
