Madonna Community Raises \$5,000 for Haitians

LIVONIA, Mich. – Members of the Society of Future Teachers (SFT) at Madonna University collected \$210.35 in “Change for Haiti.” Whether they’re delivering backpacks to pre-schoolers in Detroit, or raising funds for those in need half-way around the world, SFT members do what they can to help others. The group collected spare change from students and staff to help those in Haiti who were devastated by the earthquake.

“We were cognizant of the fact that students don’t typically have a lot of spare cash, but many of them were happy to give their change,” said Carolyn Verla, SFT publicity officer.

With the SFT check, the Madonna University community raised \$5,000 for Haitian relief.
