General Requirements for Senators

1. Students must maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale.
2. Students must maintain full-time academic status.
3. Students are expected to act appropriately and professionally on all forms of social media.
4. Students who are on University probation of any kind will not be allowed to serve on the senate until the probation has been lifted.

General Responsibilities for Senators

1. Senators shall be involved in voting for all legislation brought forward at the general assembly meetings.
2. Are required to be a member of a Student Senate committee.

 2. Diversity, Inclusion, & Religious Affairs Committee
 3. Appropriations Committee
 4. Rules and Ethics Committee
 5. Special Events Committee
 6. Wellness Committee

Eligibility for Senate Seats

Senator of Resident Students: Must live in the Residence Hall.

Senator of Commuter Students: Must be a commuter student.

Senator of the College of Arts and Humanities: Must have declared undergraduate major within the College of Arts and Humanities.

Senator of the School of Business: Must have declared undergraduate major within the School of Business.

Senator of the College of Education: Must have declared undergraduate major within the College of Education.

Senator of the College of Nursing and Health: Must have declared undergraduate major within the College of Nursing and Health (includes pre-nursing).

Senator of the College of Natural & Social Sciences: Must have declared undergraduate major within the College of Natural & Social Sciences.

Senator of the Graduate School: Must be a Graduate Student.

Senator of Transfer Students: Must be a Transfer Student.

Senator of Post-Traditional Students: Must be at least 23 years of age.*

Senator of International Students: Must be an International Student.

* *The full-time academic status does not apply to this Senate seat. Must be registered minimum of 6 credits (half-time academic status) for each semester.*
