WORK IN THE MEDICAL FIELD

The Madonna University Nurse Aide Training Program is designed to provide students with the skills necessary to perform basic health care services to residents or patients who reside in an acute or long-term care setting.

Madonna University is a State of Michigan approved Nurse Aide Training Program. It includes 65 classroom/lab hours and 24 clinical hours.

After successful completion of the Certified Nurse Aide Training Program students will be eligible to take the State of Michigan Competency Evaluation Exam. Once passed, names will be placed on the Michigan Nurse Aide Registry and will be able to start working as a Certified Nursing Assistant.

REQUIREMENTS

- 18 years or older
- Valid State of Michigan ID
- Proof of Social Security Card
- Proof of recent Tuberculosis testing
- Pass a criminal background and urine drug screen.
- Able to read and write in English at a minimum of a 10th grade level.
- Able to attend **ALL** scheduled classes. Failure to attend all scheduled class times will result in dismissal from the program.
