The Social Work Department at Madonna University in Livonia, Michigan, invites applications for **1 full-time (9 month) faculty positions at the rank of assistant or associate professor** in our Social Work Program. The positions will begin no later than August 2018.

**MADONNA UNIVERSITY** is a Franciscan, Catholic co-educational liberal arts university located in Livonia, MI, a western suburb of the metropolitan Detroit area. The growing student body of 4,000+ is an exciting and diverse mix of traditional and non-traditional commuter students representing all ages and ethnicities of Southeastern Michigan. Teaching is of primary importance and faculty are expected to actively participate in university governance, academic affairs and scholarship.

**THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WORK** is an energetic and thriving accredited BSW Program, since 1982, with over 100 full and part-time social work students and an MSW in candidacy that started in Fall 2016. We have 8 full-time faculty members and several adjunct faculty members. We also offer the Program at our outreach sites in Gaylord and Southwest Detroit. Our Program has long provided leadership to the University around issues such as diversity, social justice, accreditation standards and off-campus programming. Housed in the College of Natural and Social Sciences, the Department enjoys close collaborative relationships with colleagues across the University.

**RESPONSIBILITIES** include: a primary focus on teaching; participating in curriculum review and renewal; student matriculation, orientations, gate-keeping, recruitment and advising; compliance with CSWE standards; program assessment and evaluation; engaging in scholarly activity; collegial engagement with others; and participation in university governance and academic life.

**QUALIFICATIONS** include an MSW from a CSWE accredited school; an earned doctorate in social work or a closely related field; at least two years of post-MSW professional experience; successful teaching experience in social work education; high degree of interest, ability and/or experience promoting cultural competency and diversity; experience with CSWE standards, accreditation process, and assessment; skilled in current practices of online education preferred. Candidates with teaching and scholarship in the following areas will be given priority: *Aging, Mental Health, and Substance Abuse*. Candidates with higher education administrative experience are strongly encouraged to apply.

**THE SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATE** will articulate a commitment to the University's mission, the character and goals of a liberal arts university with a Christian perspective, values of the Social Work Profession and will contribute to the vision for the Social Work Department and Profession.
