- The Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) will satisfy all Madonna University Core Courses. MTA does not satisfy Madonna University Signature Courses.
- Madonna University will transfer a maximum of 89 credits from community colleges towards the minimum total of 120 semester hours needed for the Bachelor degree noted in the articulated agreement. Courses must be approved for transfer, non-remedial and have a grade above a 2.0 ("C") or higher
