

## January 2013

**January 1, 2013 | 9:40 a.m.**

At 9:40 a.m. an officer observed the alarm to boiler #2 in the Residence Hall sounding. Director of Facilities was notified and advised the officer to turn off the alarm. Boiler #3 was operating.

**January 4, 2013 | 11:50 a.m.**

At 11:50 a.m. an officer responded to a call from the Director of Residence concerning three unauthorized persons in the residence hall. The three were found and identified as students. One student that was previously banned from the residence hall was escorted off the property immediately. The remaining students met with the Director of Residence. A copy of the report was sent to the Vice President for Student Affairs.
