<u>Presenter Information:</u> Andi has been an interpreter since 1999 and holds her NIC and BEI 2. She received her BS degree in deaf education from MacMurray College in 1998. She was employed at the Illinois School for the Deaf for seven years before returning to her native Michigan on 2005. Since that time she has worked as both a staff and freelance interpreter. She has worked extensively in the medical and post-secondary fields.

<u>Workshop Description</u>: In this workshop, participants will develop an understanding of using practice models to understand and interpret information presented in the post-secondary settings. Participants will practice using the Colonomus, Gish and Cokely models. Emphases will be on using processing techniques to meet the demanding language and processing needs in this setting.

Educational Objectives:

- Participants will understand and practice the different processing techniques as outlined by the Colonomus, Gish and Cokely models using recorded lectures.
- Participants will discuss and debate ethical situations using scenarios provided by the presenter as well as the RID CPC
- Participants will demonstrate strategies for finding resources to develop their vocabulary and skill when interpreting in the post-secondary setting.
