4. Ability and availability to teach in-person day and evening courses in Livonia, MI, and online courses.
5. Ability to effectively use the Blackboard Ultra Learning Management System.
6. Demonstrated scholarship through presentations, publications, or professional practice preferred.

Adjunct positions are filled on a semester-by-semester, as-needed basis.
