The Biology Program invites applications for instructors to teach courses in Anatomy and Physiology.

- BIO 2450, Anatomy and Physiology I Lecture: Study of anatomical terminology, the cell, the sense organs, and the structure and function of the integumentary, skeletal, muscular, nervous, and endocrine systems.
- BIO 2450 Anatomy and Physiology I Lab: Lab course studying the structure and function of the integumentary, skeletal, muscular, nervous, and endocrine systems.
- BIO 2460, Anatomy and Physiology II Lecture: Study of circulation, respiration, digestion, excretion, reproduction and development, fluids and electrolytes, and acid-base balance.
- BIO 2460 Anatomy and Physiology II Lab: Lab course studying the structure and function of the circulatory, respiratory, lymphatic, digestive, urinary, and male and female reproductive systems.
